Born in Assisi, at the age of eighteen Clare heard Francis of Assisi preach and was inspired by his message. She became a member of the Poor Clares, a community, who practiced radical poverty like the Franciscans. Greatly revered and respected as a "new leader of women" and credited with many miracles, Clare was canonized just two years after her death.

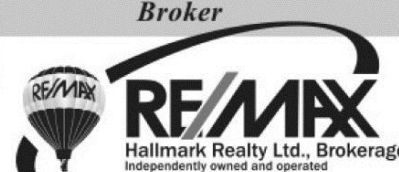

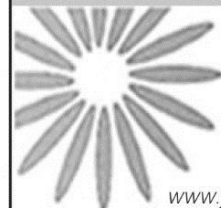
