Christ the King – in the Reception Centre; Mount Hope to St. Monica's Parish, 44 Broadway Ave. Toronto; St. Mary's to St. John Vianney Parish, 13 Baldwin Lane, Barrie.

Road Closure: No Vehicular Access between Leslie and Eglinton

- Starting July 1, there will be a temporary eight - week restriction on vehicles travelling between Leslie Street and Eglinton Avenue East. Pedestrian access between Leslie and Eglinton will be maintained.
- Vehicles approaching Eglinton southbound on Leslie must U-turn upon reaching the closure.
- Traffic on Eglinton will not be able to turn onto Leslie. East-West traffic lanes will be maintained on Eglinton.
- Access to all Leslie Street businesses will be maintained.
- TTC route 51 Leslie will U-turn at the bottom of Leslie Street. Route 54 Lawrence East will detour on Don Mills Road.
- Crosstown construction will clear out of the adjacent Bayview and Don Mills intersections before this work begins.

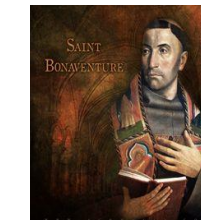

"Foxes," Jesus said, "have dens and birds of the sky have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to rest His head" (Lk 9:58). Jesus did not have a home because His house is the people—that is, us; his mission is to open all God's doors, to be the loving presence of God. ... He gives Himself totally.

What does this mean for us? ... Following Jesus means learning how to come out of ourselves—to reach out to others, ... to go to the outskirts of existence. ... Remember well: stepping outside of ourselves, like Jesus, like God has stepped outside of himself in Jesus and Jesus stepped outside of Himself for all of us.

Reaching Out Thro' Music

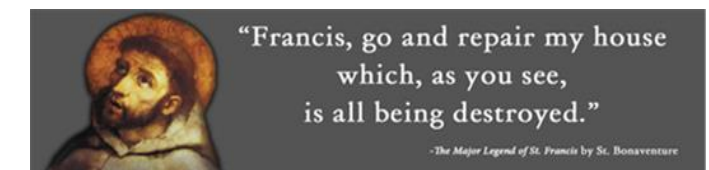
